



Behaviour Management

At Naracoorte South Primary we use a restorative approach with our students. Relationships are everything.

Rationale:

Students behaviour will support the rights of all students to learn and all teachers to teach. Success at school for all students and teachers is dependent upon student behaviour that supports a safe, productive and successful teaching environment.

Classroom Considerations:

A consistent and clear behaviour chart is provided in every classroom:

Step 1:
Verbal Reminder

Step 2:
Visual reminder recorded on behaviour chart.

Step 3.
Rethink, Restore, Ready -to-Learn
(in class reflection or buddy class)

Step 4:
Behaviour Reflection with Leadership

Major Behaviours:

There is no tolerance for:

- Physical violence
- Swearing at staff/ students
- Verbal / physical threats to staff/students
- Deliberate damage to school property
- Theft
- Persistent bullying

Consequences:

Parents will be notified if a student is displaying major behaviours in the classroom or yard. Available options for the management of students who display major behaviours are:

- Behaviour reflection with leadership
- Take home
- Suspension
- Partial Attendance
- Exclusion from school activities

Support is provided for students who require assistance to plan for change in their behaviour. The consequences of inappropriate behaviour will depend on the severity and frequency of the behaviour. With ongoing or severe inappropriate behaviour, a referral may be made to the Education Support Services.
